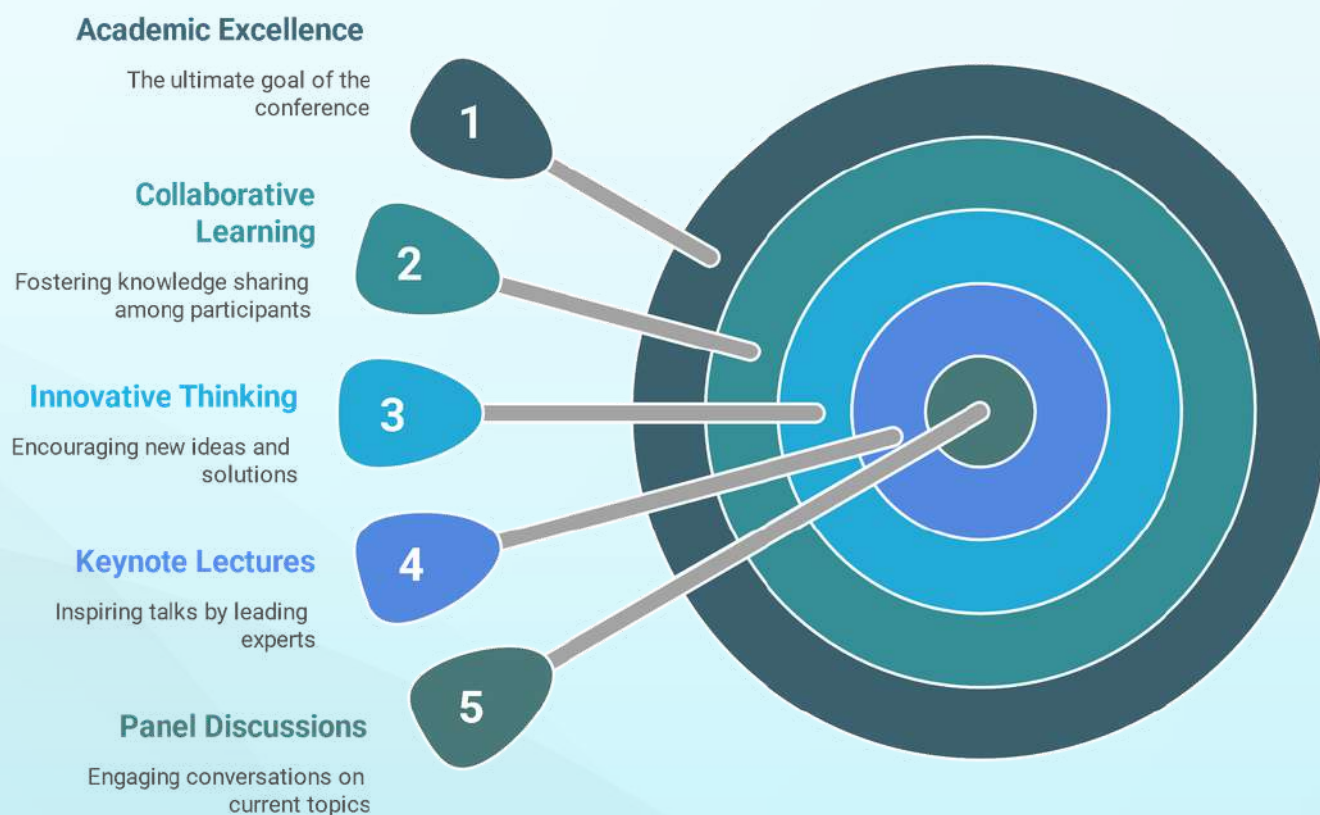

Beach RK Beach
